### Trail Type & Difficulty

LOOP TRAIL || EASY TO MODERATE

**“Loop” Trail:** A trail designed so that the route is a closed circuit connecting a number of points of interest, giving hikers the option of not traveling the same section of trail more than once on a trip.



### Total Round Trip Mileage

1.5+ MILES

An easy 1.5 mile inner loop can be extended by heading toward the outer loop as you approach or depart from the trailhead.

#### TRAIL NOTES



This 80-acre forested nature preserve boasts a mature forest dominated by beech, maple, tulip poplar, and oak, plus seasonal streams draining into bubbling Cherry Creek and a steep, scenic ravine. A diverse ecosystem, including wetland areas, supports a rich array of plants and wildlife – some rare species included.

Dogs welcome on a leash. No bicycles or motorized vehicles.

### Campsite Options, Entry Fees, & Parking Costs



**Fees:** Park at the lot on the north side of East road, between Brown Rd. and I-94. Free entry, no camping.
