LOOP(S) | MODERATE

"Loop" Trail: A trail designed so that the route is a closed circuit connecting a number of points of interest, giving hikers the option of not traveling the same section of trail more than once on a trip.

There are nine hiking trails and plenty of campsites. The Mt. Randal Loop is a combination of three trails and a shoreline walk that makes for a 4-mile trek and the best hike if you'd like a small taste of all the scenery options in this park.

Entry Fees & Parking Costs

A Michigan State Recreation Passport is required. This pass gives you entry into state parks and recreation areas, state boat launches, state forest campgrounds and state trail parking lots. Passes cost an average of \$11 - \$16 and are valid for one year.
