Trail Type & Difficulty

LOOP(S) || EASY

A loop trail is designed so that the route is a closed circuit connecting a number of points of interest, giving hikers the option of not traveling the same section of trail more than once on a trip.



Total Round Trip Mileage

0.25 MI - 8.5 MI

Sarett's more than 15 interconnected hiking loops & trails allow you to customize your total mileage -- hike a little or hike a lot.

TRAIL NOTES

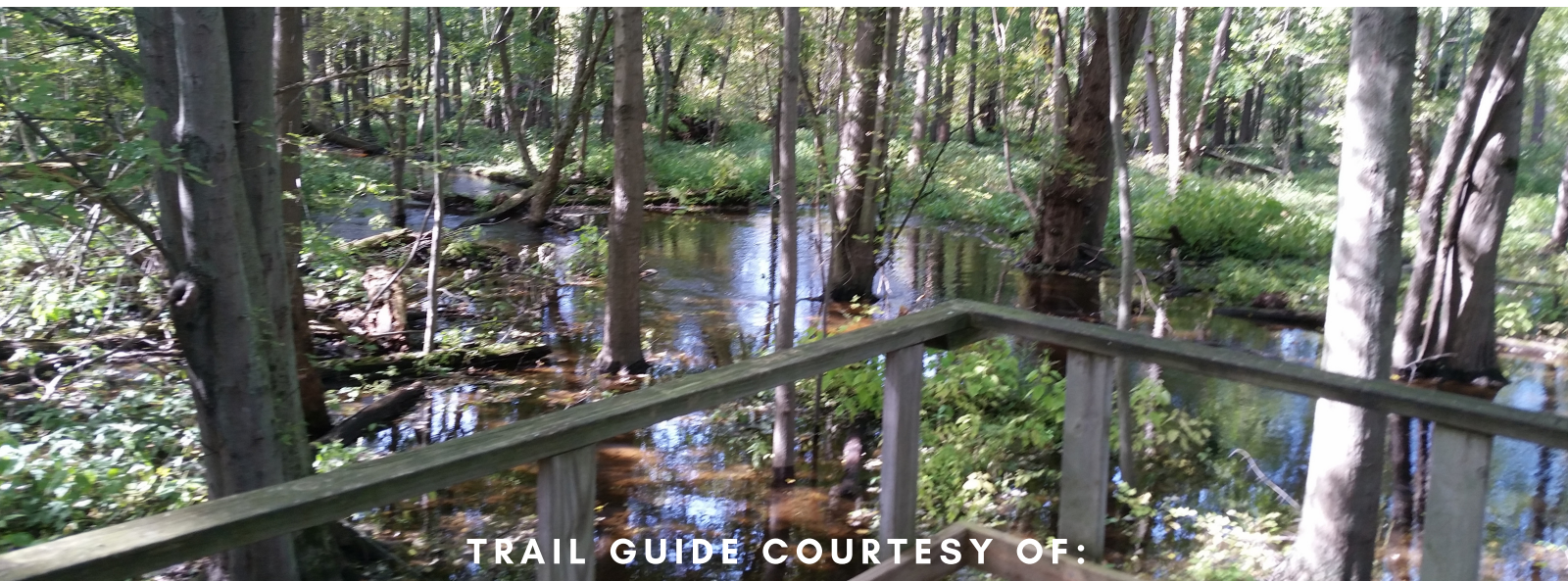
This 1,000-acre nature center features an eight-mile trail system. Be sure to check out the trails through the wetlands -- the boardwalks and observation platforms are not to be missed! In the winter there are snowshoe and cross country ski trails, a year-round visitors center, and a butterfly house in the summer. Bonus: Snowshoe & cross country ski rentals are available. No pets allowed.
