Trail Type & Difficulty

LOOP (S) || MODERATE

"Loop" Trail: A trail designed so that the route is a closed circuit connecting a number of points of interest, giving hikers the option of not traveling the same section of trail more than once on a trip.

UP TO 13 MILES

If you don't have all day, choose from one of four trails. The longest trail is the 5.2-mile Saugatuck Dunes-South Trail. Combining all loops is about a 13-mile hike.

TRAIL NOTES

This day use park comes in at approximately 1,000 acres along a secluded 2 1/2-mile strip of Lake Michigan shoreline with towering 200-feet tall dunes. Explore the park's beautiful dune land amongst the 13 mile network of trails, a mix of rolling hills and some steeper slopes. Wondering about the buildings at Saugatuck Dunes? The state acquired the land for the park from the Augustinian Order, who used the buildings for a seminary.



Entry Fees & Parking Costs

A Michigan State Recreation Passport is required. This pass gives you entry into state parks and recreation areas, state boat launches, state forest campgrounds and state trail parking lots. Passes cost an average of \$11 - \$16 and are valid for one year.
